### From Director's Desk



मुझे आपके सामने वर्ष 2022 के लिए इनिएलबनेट न्यूज़लेटर की पहली तिमाही का अंक को प्रस्तुत करते हुए खुशी हो रही है। इंडिया रैंकिंग 2022 (NIRF), IRINS: इंडियन रिसर्च इंफॉर्मेशन नेटवर्क सिस्टम, ई—शोध सिंधु, नेशनल लाइब्रेरी एंड इंफॉर्मेशन सर्विसेज इंफ्रास्ट्रक्चर फॉर स्कॉलरली कंटेंट (N-LIST), शोधशुद्धि (PDS-Ouriginal), और INFLIBNET लर्निंग मैनेजमेंट सिस्टम (ILMS) अविध के दौरान इनिएलबनेट केंद्र की प्रमुख गतिविधियां थीं. N-LIST टीम ने अब N-LIST कार्यक्रम के तहत सब्सक्राइब की गई सामग्री की बेहतर खोज के लिए पहले चरण में पांच प्रकाशकों की पित्रकाओं में एक लेख—स्तरीय खोज सुविधा जोड़ी है। और, इंडिया रैंकिंग 2022 से जुड़ा काम जोरों पर चल रहा है।

इस अविध के दौरान, इनिफ्लबनेट केंद्र ने 03 संस्थानों के लिए अपनी निः शुल्क ILMS सेवा की तैनाती की जिसमें गुजरात विद्यापीठ, अहमदाबाद; मानव रचना इंटरनेशनल इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ रिसर्च एंड स्टडीज, फरीदाबाद और एनआईआईटी विश्वविद्यालय, नीमराणा शामिल है। केंद्र ने रिपोर्ट की गई अविध तक संस्थानों के लिए कुल 475 IRINS के उदाहरण बनाए हैं, जिसमें रिपोर्ट की गई अविध के दौरान 97 उदाहरण शामिल हैं। 31 मार्च 2022 तक, कुल 681 संस्थानों (विश्वविद्यालयों + सीएफटीआई) ने इनिफ्लबनेट केंद्र के साथ शोधगंगा पर समझौता ज्ञापन पर हस्ताक्षर किए हैं, जहां रिपोर्ट की गई अविध के दौरान 27 समझौता ज्ञापन जोड़े गए थे। और, रिपोर्ट की गई अविध के दौरान शोधगंगा भंडार में अपलोड किए गए शोधपत्रों की संख्या 16,667 है, जबिक रिपोर्ट की गई अविध के अंत तक भंडार में जमा किए गए शोधपत्रों की कुल संख्या बढ़कर 3,50,000 हो गई है।

इनिष्लबनेट केंद्र ने COVID—19 महामारी की अवधि शुरू होने के बाद से अल्पकालिक और दीर्घकालिक ऑनलाइन प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम और वेबिनार आयोजित करने के लिए कई पहल की हैं। इस रिपोर्ट अवधि के दौरान, केंद्र ने क्रमशः 31 जनवरी से 4 फरवरी 2022, 21 से 25 फरवरी 2022, और 21 से 25 मार्च 2022 तक "SOUL 3.0 सॉफ्टवेयर संचालन" पर तीन



### **Dear Readers**

I'm glad to present before you the first quarter issue of the INFLIBNET Newsletter for the year 2022. India Rankings 2022 (NIRF), IRINS: Indian Research Information Network System, e-Shodh Sindhu, National Library and Information Services Infrastructure for Scholarly Content (N-LIST), Shodhshuddhi (PDS- Ouriginal), and INFLIBNET Learning Management System (ILMS) were the flagship activities of INFLIBNET Centre during the period. N-LIST Team has now added an article-level search feature in journals from five publishers in the first phase for better discovery of content subscribed under N-LIST Programme. And, the work related to India Rankings 2022 is going on in full swing mode.

During this period, the INFLIBNET Centre deployed its free ILMS service for 03 institutions in the country including Gujarat Vidyapith, Ahmedabad, Manav Rachna International Institute of Research and Studies, Faridabad and NIIT University, Neemrana. The INFLIBNET Centre has created a total number of 475 IRINS instances for institutions till the reported period including 97 IRINS instances that were created during the reported period. As on 31st March 2022, a total of 681 institutions (Universities + CFTIs) have signed MoU on Shodhganga with the INFLIBNET Centre where 27 MoUs were added during the reported period. And, the number of theses uploaded into the Shodhganga repository during the reported period is 16,667, whereas the total number of theses deposited into the repository has grown up to 3,50,000 by the end of the reported period.

The INFLIBNET Centre has taken many initiatives to conduct short-term and long-term online training programmes and webinars since the COVID-19 pandemic period started. During this reported period, the Centre conducted Three Online Training Programmes on "SOUL 3.0 Software

ऑनलाइन प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम आयोजित किए। केंद्र ने दो तीन दिवसीय विशेष ऑनलाइन प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रमः 21 से 23 फरवरी 2022 तक "अनुसंधान पद्धित और नैतिकताः साहित्यिक चोरी के मुद्दे, संदर्भ प्रबंधन उपकरण और Altmetrics", और 14 से 16 मार्च 2022 तक "ओपन सोर्स सॉफ्टवेयर का उपयोग करके डिजिटल लाइब्रेरी का निर्माण और प्रबंधन" आयोजित किए। इसके अलावा, केंद्र ने क्रमशः 8 और 9 फरवरी 2022 को Shodhganga और N-LIST विषयों पर विश्वविद्यालयों और कॉलेजों के लिए दो अल्पकालिक ऑनलाइन वेबिनार आयोजित किए। इस अविध के दौरान आयोजित उपर्युक्त कार्यक्रमों में कुल 855 प्रतिभागियों ने भाग लिया। रिपोर्ट की गई अविध के दौरान, सामाजिक न्याय और अधिकारिता मंत्रालय, राष्ट्रीय सामाजिक रक्षा संस्थान (एनआईएसडी) के ट्रांसजेंडर और भिखारी डिवीजन के अनुरोध पर केंद्र ने जिलाधिकारियों / कलेक्टरों और संबंधित अधिकारियों के लिए 'ट्रांसजेंडर व्यक्तियों के लिए राष्ट्रीय पोर्टल' पर छह ऑनलाइन प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम आयोजित किए।

केंद्र ने 13 जनवरी 2022 को महात्मा गांधी संस्थान (MGI), मॉरीशस के अधिकारियों के साथ INFLIBNET केंद्र और महात्मा गांधी संस्थान (MGI), मॉरीशस के बीच SOUL 3.0 का उपयोग करके उनकी MGI लाइब्रेरी के कम्प्यूटरीकरण के लिए एक समझौता ज्ञापन पर हस्ताक्षर करने के लिए एक आभासी बैठक की।

इनिफलबनेट केंद्र ने अपने सभी कर्मचारियों और उनके परिवार के साथ केंद्र परिसर में 26 जनवरी 2022 को 73वां गणतंत्र दिवस मनाया। केंद्र ने 1 मार्च 2022 को प्रोफेसर (सुश्री) सुषमा यादव, सदस्य, विश्वविद्यालय अनुदान आयोग और पूर्व कुलपित, भगत फूल सिंह महिला विश्वविद्यालय, खानपुर कलां, हरियाणा द्वारा "21वीं सदी में नेतृत्व में महिलाएं" पर एक विशेष व्याख्यान आयोजित करके महिला दिवस भी मनाया।

The Centre held a virtual meeting with the officials of Mahatma Gandhi Institute (MGI), Mauritius to sign an MoU between the INFLIBNET Centre and Mahatma Gandhi Institute (MGI), Mauritius for the computerization of their MGI Library using SOUL 3.0 on 13<sup>th</sup> January 2022.



The INFLIBNET Centre organized a three-day Online Training Programme on Research Methodology and Ethics: Plagiarism Issues, Reference Management Tools, and Altmetrics from 21st to 23rd February 2022. Prof J P Singh Joorel, Hon'ble Director, INFLIBNET Centre inaugurated the programme in the august presence of University Coordinators of Shodhganga & ShodhShuddhi, research scholars, and library professionals from various Universities and institutions across India. In his inaugural address, he highlighted the UGC Regulation 2018, Promotion of Academic Integrity and Prevention of Plagiarism in Higher Educational Institutions, and requested all the participants to create awareness among the research scholars to promote academic integrity and prevention of misconduct of plagiarism. He also informed the participants about the latest Notification issued by UGC to all the INIs/CFTIs and Universities for

uploading the full-text theses in Shodhganga which are linked with NIRF ranking. Mr Manoj Kumar K welcomed the participants with a brief overview of the programme and informed the about the landmark UGC Notifications regarding the submission of the electronic version of theses and dissertations to Shodhganga. He also talked about the research ethics/academic honesty & plagiarism issues.

# INFLIBNET Centre as an Anchor Institute for SWAYAM-MOOC Course on Research Ethics

The 4 credit UGC SWAYAM-MOOC course (15 Weeks) on Research Ethics under 'Development

of Non-Technology PG Degree Online Courses' was successfully conducted for the 3<sup>rd</sup> consecutive year in the 2021 (July-December'2021) Semester.

There were 3063 learners & students enrolled in this course which is conducted by the INFLIBNET

Centre as an Anchor Institute and the Central University of Himachal Pradesh as the Host Institute. The majority of age groups enrolled in the course were between 20 - 30 years old (1313 out of 3063) and 50.14% were students, 33.10% were faculty members, 9.27% were employed and 7.44% were others as per the SWAYAM portal. Each module has 10 graded questions comprising 15 Internal Assessments (Quiz/MCQs). Further, 914 students/learners registered for the final exam which was conducted on 21<sup>st</sup> & 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2022 by the National Testing Agency (NTA) and it is recorded

as the highest number of students registered for the final examination. Paper Evaluation of Answer Booklets of 914 students for Final Examination (Pen & Paper) have been evaluated and completed on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022.

Shri Manoj Kumar K, Scientist-E (CS), INFLIBNET Centre, Gandhinagar, Gujarat was the Course Coordinator (CC) for the MOOC course.

## **Indian Research Information Network System (IRINS)**

IRINS is a web-based Research Information Management (RIM) service provided to higher education institutions in India by the INFLIBNET Centre. IRINS facilitates the academic, R&D organizations and faculty members, and scientists to collect, curate and showcase the scholarly communication activities and provide an opportunity to create a scholarly network. The INFLIBNET Centre has created a total number of 475 IRINS instances for institutions till the reported period including 97 IRINS instances that were created during the period under report. IRINS has connected 75,804+ faculty members through this project. The project retrieved 13.45 lakhs+ of publications metadata from various sources and received 1,48 lakhs+ of citations & received 41.84 lakhs + of Altmetrics mentions till the reported period.

## INFLIBNET Learning Management Service (ILMS)

INFLIBNET Learning Management Service (ILMS) is a service offered by the Information and Library Network Centre to institutions of higher education across the country. This service is being offered to all the Central, State and Deemed universities. Some of the core features are Course creation, Enrolment, Assignment & Assessment, Discussion forum, etc. During this report period, the INFLIBNET Centre deployed its free ILMS service for 03 institutions in the country including Manav Rachna International Institute of Research and Studies, Faridabad; NIIT University, Neemrana; and Gujarat Vidyapith, Ahmedabad.

## Launching of ILMS at University of Jammu, Jammu on 10<sup>th</sup> January 2022

Prof J P Singh Joorel, Director, INFLIBNET Centre, Gandhinagar informed that the Centre has been working as a facilitator for setting up INFLIBNET Learning Management Service (ILMS) with pre-populated e-content developed under e-PG Pathshala and other available open access content with an aim to make all the e-content available to the academic and research community. He said that the ILMS platform will also enable stakeholders to get a fair idea about e-content development & uploading, hands-on experience on open-source learning management systems, on similar lines such as MOODLE platform, in a customized way of LMS. Earlier Prof Pankaj K Srivastava, Convener, ILMS welcomed the dignitaries and briefed them about the launching of ILMS for Jammu University. Prof Arvind Jasrotia, Registrar, Dr Meenakshi Kilam,

Director DIQA and Rector Kathua Campus, Er Anik Gupta, Director IT Services congratulated all the stakeholders for the launching of INFLIBNET Learning Management Service for the University of Jammu.



## **Shodhganga**

Shodhganga: a repository of full-text theses in Indian Universities has grown progressively during the period under report. As on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022, 681 (Universities+CFTIs/INIs) have signed MoU on Shodhganga with the INFLIBNET Centre where 27 MoUs (15 Univ+12 CFTs/INIs) were added during the period. The total number of theses deposited in the repository has grown up to 3,50,000 by the contribution of 538 contributing Universities whereas 50,000 Theses have been submitted to the repository in the FY (April 2021-March 2022).

Whereas in Shodhgangotri, a total of 8571 Synopses/MRPs/PDFs/Fellowships have been submitted to the repository.

The total theses uploaded in Quarter-1 (January-March 2022) are 16,667 which is 54% higher than last quarter (Q4 i.e. 10803 Theses in October-December 2021). Figure-1 shows the Theses uploaded during January - March 2022 is 16,667 whereas the total Theses submitted to the repository has reached 3,50,000.



(Figure-1: Theses uploaded to Shodhganga January - March)


## ShodhShuddhi and Plagiarism Detection Software (PDS)

The Ministry of Education through its initiative ShodhShuddhi provides access to Plagiarism Detection Software (PDS) to all universities including Central, State, Deemed, and Private Universities, as well as Centrally funded Technical Institutions (CFTIs) in India through Central funding to enhance academic integrity in academic institutions and to curb plagiarism, w.e.f. 01<sup>st</sup> September 2019. This program was launched by the Hon'ble Minister of Education during the CABE meeting in Vigyan Bhavan, New Delhi and it is being executed by the INFLIBNET Centre, Gandhinagar. As on 31st March 2022, a total of 19,88,174 documents have been submitted for checking Plagiarism by 1,27,777 users from 817 Universities/institutions. The rest of the Universities/institutions are either using any other software or research programmes that have not yet started there.


## PDS (URKUND) Usage Statistics

After the lockdown relaxation, submission into PDS has increased as researchers and students are gradually coming back to research and academic

activities. Figure-4 shows the average number of submissions in the last 3 months (January-February-March 2022), and the average was 63316. Figure-5 shows the number of users added to ShodhShuddhi from January to March 2022.

The graph (Figure-5) shows the total number of users created/added in ShodhShuddhi to date is 1,27,777 users whereas the number of users added monthly (January-February-March. 2022 = 5956) are as follows (January= 1375, February= 1336, and March= 3245). PDS has a provision for 3 Lakhs users from all Universities.




## **New Appointments**


