## From Director's Desk



### ( प्रिय पाठको )

मुझे आपके सामने वर्ष 2022 के लिए इनफ्लिबनेट न्यूज़लेटर की तीसरा तिमाही का अंक को प्रस्तुत करते हुए खुशी हो रही है। मुझे आपको यह बताते हुए बहुत खुशी हो रही है कि उच्च शिक्षा विभाग, शिक्षा मंत्रालय ने ISBN के आवंटन और इसके दैनिक रखरखाव के लिए एक नई वेबसाइट के विकास के लिए इनफ्लिबनेट केंद्र, गांधीनगर के परियोजना प्रस्ताव को मंजूरी दे दी है। शोध जीवन चक्र के दौरान शैक्षणिक समुदाय की मदद और समर्थन करने के लिए केंद्र की अनूठी पहल शोध-चक्र को देश भर के विश्वविद्यालयों से जबरदस्त प्रतिक्रिया मिल रही है, और रिपोर्ट की गई अवधि तक, देश में कुल 44 विश्वविद्यालयों ने इनफ्लिबनेट केंद्र के साथ शोध-चक्र का उपयोग करने के लिए समझौता ज्ञापन पर हस्ताक्षर कर चुके हैं जिस में रिपोर्ट अवधि के दौरान 30 विश्वविद्यालयों सामिल हैं।

इनफ्लिबनेट केंद्र ने NIRF के तहत India Rankings 2022 को सफलतापूर्वक अंजाम दिया, जिसे माननीय शिक्षा मंत्री श्री धर्मेन्द्र प्रधान ने माननीय शिक्षा राज्य मंत्री, श्रीमती अन्नपूर्णा देवी, माननीय शिक्षा राज्य मंत्री, डॉ सुभाष सरकार, और माननीय विदेश और शिक्षा राज्य मंत्री, डॉ राजकुमार रंजन सिंह की उपस्थिति 15 जुलाई 2022 को नई दिल्ली में जारी किया। और इनफ्लिबनेट केंद्र द्वारा किए गए कार्यों की वहां अत्यधिक सराहना की गई।

इस अवधि के दौरान, इनफ्लिबनेट केंद्र ने अपनी निः शुल्क ILMS सेवा की तैनाती केवल एक संस्थान कृष्णा इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ मेडिकल साइंसेज यूनिवर्सिटी (KIMSU), कराड, महाराष्ट्र के लिए किया। केंद्र ने रिपोर्ट की गई अवधि तक संस्थानों के लिए कुल 604 IRINS के उदाहरण बनाए हैं, जिसमें रिपोर्ट की गई अवधि के दौरान 67 उदाहरण शामिल हैं। 30 सितंबर 2022 तक, कुल 719 संस्थानों (665 विश्वविद्यालयों + 54 सीएफटीआई) ने इनफ्लिबनेट

### Dear Readers

I'm glad to present before you the third quarter issue of the INFLIBNET Newsletter for the year 2022. I'm very happy to inform you that the Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education has approved the project proposal of the INFLIBNET Centre, Gandhinagar for the development of a new website for allotment of ISBN and its day-to-day maintenance. Shodh-Chakra, the unique initiative of the Centre to help and support the academic community during the research life cycle, is receiving an overwhelming response from universities across the country, and till the reported period, a total of 44 universities in the country have signed MoUs with the INFLIBNET Centre to use Shodh-Chakra including 30 universities during the period under report.

The INFLIBNET Centre successfully executed the India Rankings 2022 under NIRF, which was released by Hon'ble Education Minister Shri Dharmendra Pradhan in the august presence of Hon'ble Minister of State for Education, Smt Annapurna Devi, Hon'ble Minister of State for Education, Dr Subhas Sarkar and Hon'ble Minister of State for External Affairs and Education, Dr Rajkumar Ranjan Singh on 15<sup>th</sup> July 2022 at New Delhi. And the work done by the INFLIBNET Centre was highly appreciated there.

During this period, the INFLIBNET Centre deployed its free ILMS service to only one institution Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences University (KIMSU), Karad, Maharashtra. The INFLIBNET Centre has created a total number of 604 IRINS instances for institutions till the reported period including 67 IRINS instances that were created during the reported period. As on 30<sup>th</sup> September 2022, a total of 719 (665 Universities + 54 CFTIs/INIs) have signed MoU on Shodhganga with the INFLIBNET Centre where 15 MoUs (11 Universities + 04



केंद्र के साथ शोधगंगा पर समझौता ज्ञापन पर हस्ताक्षर किए हैं, जहां रिपोर्ट की गई अवधि के दौरान 15 समझौता (11 विश्वविद्यालयों + 04 सीएफटीआई) ज्ञापन जोड़े गए थे। और, शोधगंगा भंडार में जमा किए गए शोध प्रबंधों की कुल संख्या रिपोर्ट की गई अवधि के अंत तक बढ़कर 3,86,264 हो गई है, जिसमें रिपोर्ट की गई अवधि के दौरान अपलोड किए गए 17,993 शोध-प्रबंध शामिल हैं। इसमें कुल 572 विश्वविद्यालय योगदान दे रहे हैं।

इनफिलबनेट केंद्र देश भर के विभिन्न संस्थानों के प्रतिभागियों के बीच प्रशिक्षण प्रदान करने के लिए नियमित रूप से ऑफलाइन/ऑनलाइन विशिष्ट प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम और कार्यशालाएं आयोजित करता है। रिपोर्ट की गई तिमाही के दौरान, केंद्र ने SOUL सॉफ्टवेयर उपयोगकर्ताओं के लिए 4 से 8 जुलाई 2022, 22 से 29 जुलाई 2022 और 22 से 26 अगस्त 2022 तक "SOUL 3.0: इंस्टॉलेशन और संचालन" पर तीन प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम आयोजित किए। इसके अलावा, केंद्र ने चार अन्य विशिष्ट कार्यक्रमों का जैसे 18 से 22 जुलाई 2022 "ग्रंथसूची और अनुसंधान आउटपुट विश्लेषण" पर एक पांच दिवसीय उन्नत प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम, 10 से 12 अगस्त 2022 तक "अनुसंधान सूचना प्रबंधन प्रणाली (RIMS)" पर एक तीन दिवसीय कार्यशाला, 29 से 31 अगस्त 2022 तक "नैतिक मुद्दे और शोध में साहित्यिक चोरी का उपयोग" पर एक तीन दिवसीय राष्ट्रीय कार्यशाला और 7 से 9 सितंबर 2022 तक "क्लाउड टेक्नोलॉजी फॉर लाइब्रेरी प्रोफेशनल्स" पर एक तीन दिवसीय राष्ट्रीय कार्यशाला आयोजन किया। रिपोर्ट की गई अवधि के दौरान, केंद्र ने सामाजिक न्याय और अधिकारिता मंत्रालय, राष्ट्रीय सामाजिक रक्षा संस्थान (एनआईएसडी) के ट्रांसजेंडर और भिखारी प्रभाग के अनुरोध पर त्रिपुरा राज्य के जिला मजिस्ट्रेट / कलेक्टर और संबंधित अधिकारियों के लिए 'ट्रांसजेंडर व्यक्तियों के लिए राष्ट्रीय पोर्टल' पर 06 जुलाई 2022 को एक ऑनलाइन पुनश्चर्चा प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम आयोजित किया। इनफिलबनेट केंद्र ने रिपोर्ट की गई अवधि के दौरान विभिन्न विश्वविद्यालयों के लिए शोध-चक्र पर पांच (1-सामान्य और 4-संस्थागत) ऑनलाइन प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम आयोजित किए।

इनफिलबनेट केंद्र ने 15 अगस्त 2022 को अपने परिसर में 76वां स्वतंत्रता दिवस मनाया। प्रो जे पी सिंह जूरेल, निदेशक, इनफिलबनेट केंद्र ने राष्ट्रीय ध्वज फहराया, और उस अवसर पर उपस्थित कर्मचारियों और उनके परिवारों को संबोधित किया। केंद्र में 14 सितंबर 2022 को हिंदी दिवस और 14 से 29 सितंबर 2022 तक हिंदी पखवाड़ा मनाया गया। साथ ही, 22 सितंबर 2022 को हिंदी पखवाड़ा के अवसर पर "भारतीय सांस्कृतिक एकता और हिंदी" पर एक दिवसीय संगोष्ठी का आयोजन किया गया।

A total of 572 Universities are contributing to it.

During the reported period, the Centre on the request from the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, the Transgender & Beggary Division of the National Institute of Social Defence (NISD), conducted one online refresher programme on the 'National Portal for Transgender Persons' for the District Magistrates/Collectors and concerned officials of Tripura state on 06<sup>th</sup> July 2022. The INFLIBNET Centre organized five (1-General and 4-Institutional) online training programmes on Shodh-Chakra for different universities during the reported period.

The INFLIBNET Centre celebrated the 76<sup>th</sup> Independence Day on 15<sup>th</sup> August 2022 at its premise. Prof J P Singh Joorel, Director, INFLIBNET Centre hoisted the National Flag and addressed the gatherings of the staff members and their families on that occasion. The INFLIBNET Centre organized five-day Advanced Training Programme on “Bibliometric and Research Output Analysis” from 18<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2022 at INFLIBNET Centre, Gandhinagar. Prof J P Singh Joorel, Director, INFLIBNET Centre inaugurated the training programme and addressed the participants during the event. ## INFLIBNET Learning Management Service (ILMS)

INFLIBNET Learning Management Service (ILMS) is a service offered by the Information and Library Network Centre to institutions of higher education across the country. This service is being offered to all the Central, State and Deemed universities. Some of the core features are Course creation, Enrolment, Assignment & Assessment, Discussion forum, etc. During this reported period, the INFLIBNET Centre deployed its free ILMS service to one institution that is Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences University (KIMSU), Karad, Maharashtra.

## Indian Research Information Network System (IRINS)

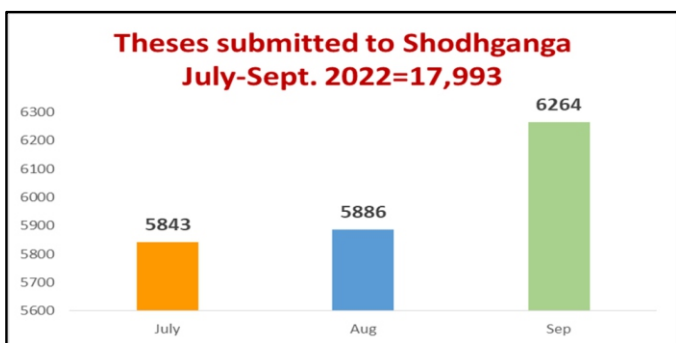
IRINS is a web-based Research Information Management (RIM) service provided to higher education institutions in India by the INFLIBNET Centre. IRINS facilitates the academic, R&D organizations and faculty members, and scientists to collect, curate and showcase scholarly communication activities and provides an opportunity to create a scholarly network. The INFLIBNET Centre has created 604 IRINS instances for institutions until the reported period, including 67 IRINS instances created during the period under the report. IRINS has connected a total of 921,80

faculty members through this project. The project retrieved a total of 1572,460 publications metadata from various sources and received a total of 164,90,482 citations & received a total of 49,48,210 Altmetrics mentions till the reported period.

## Shodhganga: a reservoir of Indian Theses

Shodhganga: a reservoir of Indian theses, the repository of full-text theses in Indian Universities has grown progressively during the period under report. As on 30<sup>th</sup> September 2022, a total of 719 (665 Universities + 54 CFTIs/INIs) have signed MoU on Shodhganga with the INFLIBNET Centre where 15 MoUs (11 Universities + 04 CFTIs/INIs) were added during the reported period. And the total number of theses deposited into the Shodhganga repository has grown up to 3,86,264 by the end of the reported period by the contribution of 572 contributing Universities.

The total number of theses uploaded in the Quarter-Q3 (July-September 2022) was 17,993 as depicted in (Figure 1).

## Bulk Upload of Metadata Interface added to Shodhganga:

There were a lot of requests from Institutions who had their own repository (IR) for Theses and transferred the same metadata to Shodhganga to avoid duplication of work. Those requests were mainly from CFTIs/INIs who have decided to join Shodhganga lately. Thus, based on the requirement Shodhganga division has developed an interface to support bulk metadata upload of Thesis with one click in its intermediate server. The metadata format is designed by the INFLIBNET Centre to maintain the standards of metadata based on the modified Dublin Core standard. The format can be requested from the INFLIBNET Centre or downloaded from their University Coordinator account login.

The new interface has been designed during the months of July-September 2022 for Bulk uploading of the metadata by the CFTIs and initial testing was done with the Indian Institute of Technology Guwahati. The INFLIBNET Centre is successful in testing the interface with 2000+ metadata created by IITGW in their IR. IITGW harvested their metadata from their IR and curated it as per the INFLIBNET Centre's template. The Centre has checked and verified the Naming Standards and missing fields in order to maintain the standards for various metadata fields like rendering of Names for Research Scholars and Guides, Title, Abstract, Date of Award/Completion etc.

This newly designed feature Interface tested with IITGW can be extended to all CFTIs and Universities. The CFTIs/Universities can upload the bulk metadata of their theses records through the import metadata option, thereafter, upload full text



in due course of time. This will help the CFTIs comply with the circular issued through the Ministry of Education for NIRF.

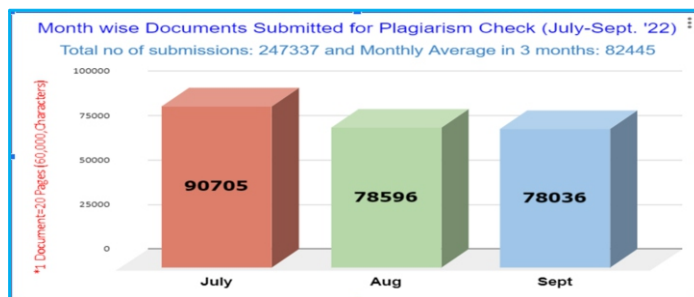
## ShodhShuddhi and Plagiarism Detection Software (PDS)

The Ministry of Education through its initiative ShodhShuddhi provides access to Plagiarism Detection Software (PDS) to all universities including Central, State, Deemed, and Private Universities, as well as Centrally funded Technical Institutions (CFTIs) in India through Central funding

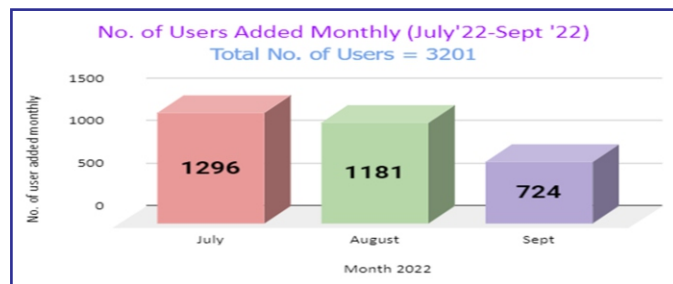
to enhance academic integrity in academic institutions and to curb plagiarism, w.e.f. 01<sup>st</sup> September 2019. This program was launched by the Hon'ble Minister of Education during the CABE meeting in Vigyan Bhavan, New Delhi and it is being executed by INFLIBNET Centre, Gandhinagar. As on 30th September 2022, a total of 2.5 million (25 Lakhs) documents have been submitted for checking plagiarism by 1,33,707 users from 860 Universities/institutions. The rest of the Universities/institutions are either using any other software or research programmes are not yet started there.

### PDS (ORIGINAL) Usage Statistics

Figure-4 shows the average number of submissions in the last 3 months (July-August-September 2022), and the average was 82445. Figure-5 shows the number of users added to ShodhShuddhi from July-September 2022.

The graph (Figure-5) shows the total number of users created/added in ShodhShuddhi to date are 1,33,707 users whereas the number of users added monthly (July-August-September 2022 = 3201) are as follows (July = 1296, August = 1181, and September = 724).

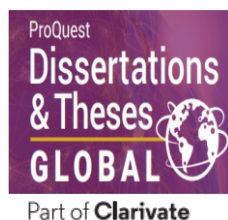

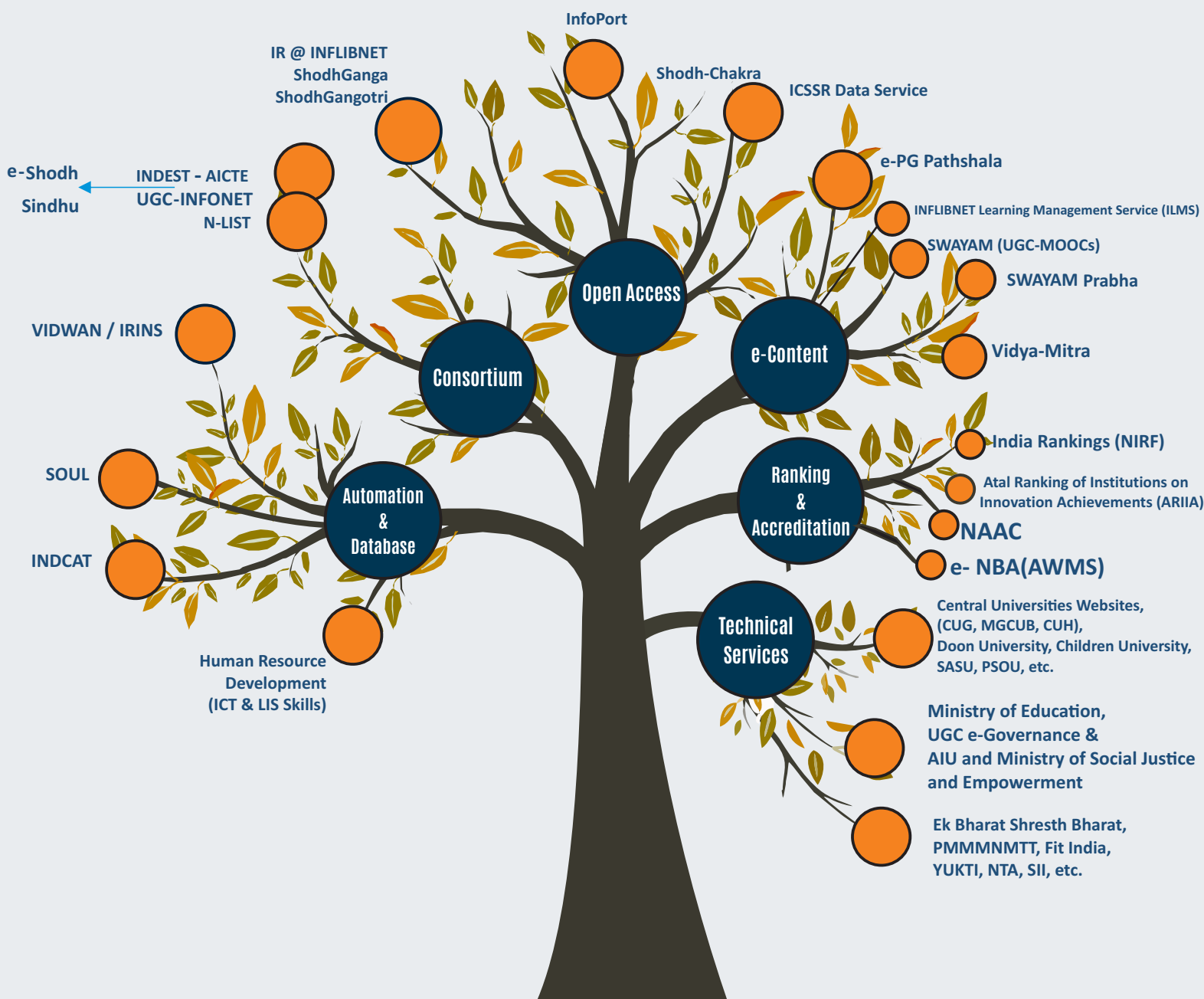
