### ( प्रिय पाठको )

वर्ष २०२० के इनफिलबनेट न्यूज़लेटर की अंतिम अंक को आपके सामने प्रस्तुत करते हुए मुझे बहुत खुशी हो रही है। कोविड-१९ राष्ट्रीय लॉकडाउन के लिए भारत सरकार की रियायत और फिर धीरे-धीरे चरणबद्ध रूप से खुलने के बाद, केंद्र ने अक्टूबर २०२० के दूसरे सप्ताह से अपनी पूरी क्षमता के साथ काम करना शुरू कर दिया। नेशनल इंस्टीट्यूशनल रैंकिंग फ्रेमवर्क (छप्थ) के तहत इंडिया रैंकिंग २०२१ से संबंधित काम, और इनोवेशन अचीवमेंट्स पर संस्थानों की अटल रैंकिंग (ARIIA 2021) रिपोर्ट के तहत अवधि के दौरान शुरू हुई।

इस अवधि के दौरान, इनफिलबनेट सेंटर ने ०५ संस्थानों के लिए अपनी नि: शुल्क ILMS सेवा की तैनाती की जिसमें गोंडवाना विश्वविद्यालय, गढ़चिरोली; दूरस्थ शिक्षा निदेशालय, डीएवीवी इंदौर; सुमनदीप विद्यापीठ, वडोदरा; इंडियन इंस्टीट्यूट ऑफ टीचर एजुकेशन (IITE), गांधीनगर; और मदन मोहन मालवीय प्रौद्योगिकी विश्वविद्यालय, गोरखपुर शामिल हैं। केंद्र ने सामाजिक न्याय और अधिकारिता मंत्रालय, भारत सरकार के लिए 'नेशनल पोर्टल फॉर ट्रांसजेंडर पर्सन्स' पोर्टल विकसित किया, जिसे अवधि के दौरान कार्यात्मक बनाया। इसके अलावा, केंद्र ने HRM कार्यालय, शिक्षा मंत्रालय, नई दिल्ली के लिए केंद्रीय विद्यालय संगठन मॉड्यूल विकसित किया।

इस रिपोर्ट के अवधि के दौरान, इनफिलबनेट सेंटर ने अल्पकालिक और दीर्घकालिक ऑनलाइन प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम और वेबिनार आयोजित करने के लिए कई पहल की हैं। इस रिपोर्ट की अवधि के दौरान, केंद्र ने ०२ - ०६ नवंबर २०२० के दौरान SOUL 2.0 की अधिष्ठापन और संचालन पर एक ऑनलाइन प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम आयोजित किया। इसके अलावा, केंद्र ने इस रिपोर्ट अवधि के दौरान शैक्षणिक और अनुसंधान से संबंधित विभिन्न विषयों पर ०८ ऑनलाइन वेबिनार आयोजित किए। केंद्र ने दो ऑनलाइन प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम: ०५ - ०६ अक्टूबर २०२० के दौरान 'ओपन सोर्स सॉफ्टवेयर का उपयोग करके डिजिटल लाइब्रेरी का निर्माण और प्रबंधन' पर पांच दिवसीय ऑनलाइन राष्ट्रीय कार्यशाला, और २५ - २७ नवंबर २०२० के दौरान 'शोधगंगा और साहित्यिक मुद्दों' पर तीन दिवसीय ऑनलाइन उन्नत प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम आयोजित किए। इसके अलावा, इस अवधि के दौरान केंद्र ने ०६ - १३ नवंबर २०२० के दौरान 'क्लाउड प्रौद्योगिकी' पर एक पांच दिवसीय संकाय विकास कार्यक्रम (FDP), और १५ से १७ दिसंबर २०२० के दौरान 'आईसीएसएसआर डेटा सर्विस' पर आईसीएसएसआर, नई दिल्ली के कर्मचारियों के लिए तीन दिवसीय क्षमता निर्माण कार्यक्रम का आयोजित किया। मुझे यह बताते हुए खुशी हो रही है कि इनफिलबनेट केंद्र ने इस अवधि के दौरान पुस्तकालय स्वचालन सॉफ्टवेयर SOUL 3.0 का नया संस्करण लाया है।

I'm glad to present before you the last issue of the INFLIBNET Newsletter for the year 2020. After the Central Government of India's relaxation for COVID-19 national lockdown, and phased reopening afterwards, the Centre started functioning with its full capacity from the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of October 2020. The work related to India Rankings 2021 under National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF), and Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievements (ARIIA 2021) started during the period under report.

During this period, the INFLIBNET Centre has deployed its free ILMS service for 05 institutions including Gondwana University, Gadchiroli; Directorate of Distance Education, DAVV Indore; Sumandeep Vidyapeeth Deemed to be University, Vadodara; Indian Institute of Teacher Education (IITE), Gandhinagar; and Madan Mohan Malaviya University of Technology, Gorakhpur. During this COVID lockdown period under report, the INFLIBNET Centre has taken many initiatives to conduct short-term and long-term online training programmes and webinars. During this report period, the Centre conducted one Online Training Programme on 'Installation and Operations of SOUL 2.0' during 02<sup>nd</sup> - 06<sup>th</sup> November 2020. Apart from this, the Centre conducted 08 Online Webinars on different topics related to academic and research during this report period. The Centre conducted two online training programmes, i.e. a Five-day Online National Workshop on "Creation and Management of Digital Library using Open Source Software" during 05<sup>th</sup> - 09<sup>th</sup> October 2020, and a Three-day Online Advanced Training Programme on Shodhganga and Plagiarism Issues during 25<sup>th</sup> - 27<sup>th</sup> November 2020. # Upcoming SOUL 3.0

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Historically, the first version of the software, i.e. SOUL 1.0 was released during CALIBER 2000. Then the current ongoing version of the software, i.e. SOUL 2.0 was released in January 2009. SOUL 2.0 is compliant to international standards such as MARC21 bibliographic format, Unicode based Universal Character Sets for multilingual bibliographic records and NCIP 2.0 and SIP 2 based protocols for RFID for electronic surveillance and control. SOUL 2.0 is currently installed at 3781 institutions (as on 31-12-2020) that includes some of the biggest academic libraries like Banaras Hindu University, University of Mumbai, University of Madras, Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda, Gujarat University etc. SOUL clientele also include quite a good number of public libraries, school libraries and special libraries.

Based on the suggestions and feedback received from the various institutes and library professionals across the country as well as to accommodate the latest advancement in IT, the newer version of the software SOUL 3.0 is ready to be released. During the development process INFLIBNET Centre has a consulted number of practicing professionals at all levels, i.e. university librarians to data-entry operators, considered their suggestions and after several brainstorming sessions within the internal core committee specially constituted for this purpose. At first, the beta version was developed and installed in a few libraries and after vigorous testing the final version of SOUL 3.0 was made production ready.

The SOUL 3.0 contains all the features and functionalities of the earlier version. The prime focus of this release was to be more user friendly with enhanced functionalities, and this has been achieved by providing device independent responsive theme, touch compatible user interface, customizable colors and font size etc. This version is having user selectable language interface, currently integration of “Hindi” language has been done (as shown below in Figure-2) with the help of Central Library, BHU and integration of other languages are in progress. The new interface also provides a very intuitive dashboard (as shown below in Figure-1) to facilitate librarian to have important information at a glance. The list of added major features are as follows:

Lastly, the existing users will be notified soon regarding the upgrade and changeover procedure.

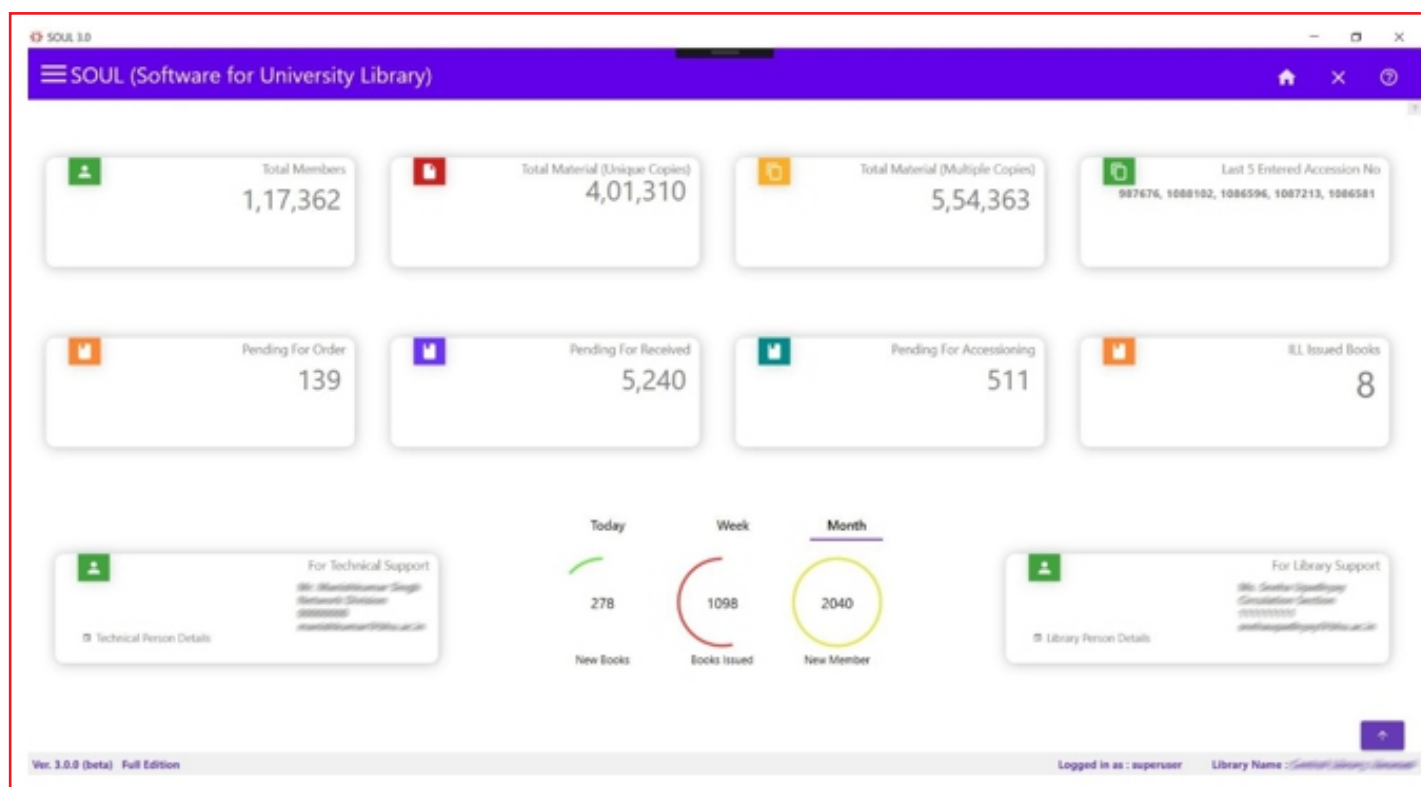


Figure-1: (SOUL 3.0 Dashboard)

## Current Status of INFLIBNET Projects

### India Rankings 2021 under National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF)

The work related to India Rankings 2021 under National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) started during the period under report. The INFLIBNET Centre has been given the task to execute the 6<sup>th</sup> exercise of NIRF i.e. India Rankings 2021. This year the registration for Institutions was started on 1st December 2020 and closed on 24<sup>th</sup> December 2020. More than 4500+ Institutions have registered for India Rankings 2021.

### Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievements (ARIIA)

The work related to Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievements (ARIIA 2021), an initiative of the Ministry of Education (MoE), Govt. of India started during the period under report. The registration & Pre-Qualifier for ARIIA 2021 was opened and started from 17th September 2020. And, the Data Submission Portal started on 7<sup>th</sup> December 2020 which will be available till 15<sup>th</sup> Feb 2021.

### INFLIBNET Learning Management Service

INFLIBNET Learning Management Service (ILMS) is a service offered by the Information and Library Network Centre (An IUC of UGC) to the institutions of higher education across the country. This service is being offered to all the Central, State and Deemed universities on request basis. It provides pre-populated learning content,

derived from e-PG Pathshala: A Gateway to PG Courses, as per the prevailing guidelines of UGC. It is one of the major initiatives of the Centre, which is playing a role of Covid warrior for the academic community. The Centre has deployed this ILMS for Gondwana University Gadchiroli, Directorate of Distance Education, DAVV Indore, Sumandeep Vidyapeeth Deemed to be University, IITE, Gandhinagar, and Madan Mohan Malaviya University of Technology Gorakhpur during this reported period.

## **National Portal for Transgender Persons (Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment)**

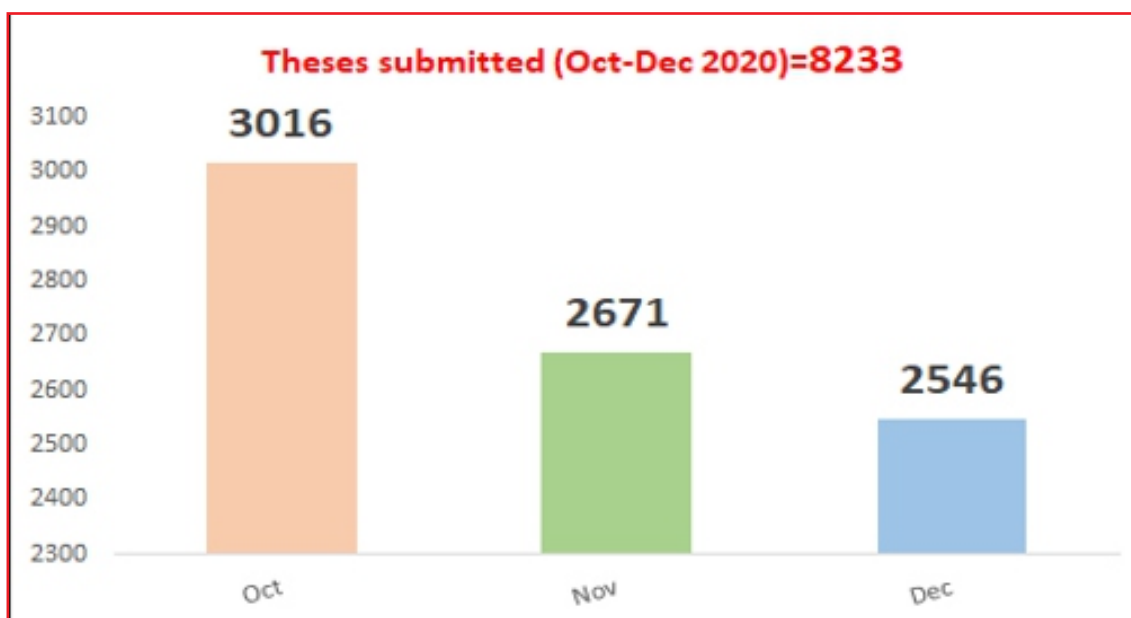
The 'National Portal for Transgender Persons' was developed by the INFLIBNET Centre for the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, GoI during the period and made it functional on Wednesday, 25<sup>th</sup> December 2020. This Portal was developed within 2 months of Notification of Transgender Persons (Protection of Rights) Rules, 2020 on 29 September, 2020. The portal “transgender.dosje.gov.in” enables a transgender person to apply for a certificate and identity card digitally from anywhere in the country, without having to visit any office. The most important benefit is that it helps the transgender person to get the I-Card without any physical interface and without having to visit any office. Through the Portal, they can track/monitor the status of their application and register their grievances in case of delays that ensure transparency in the process as well.

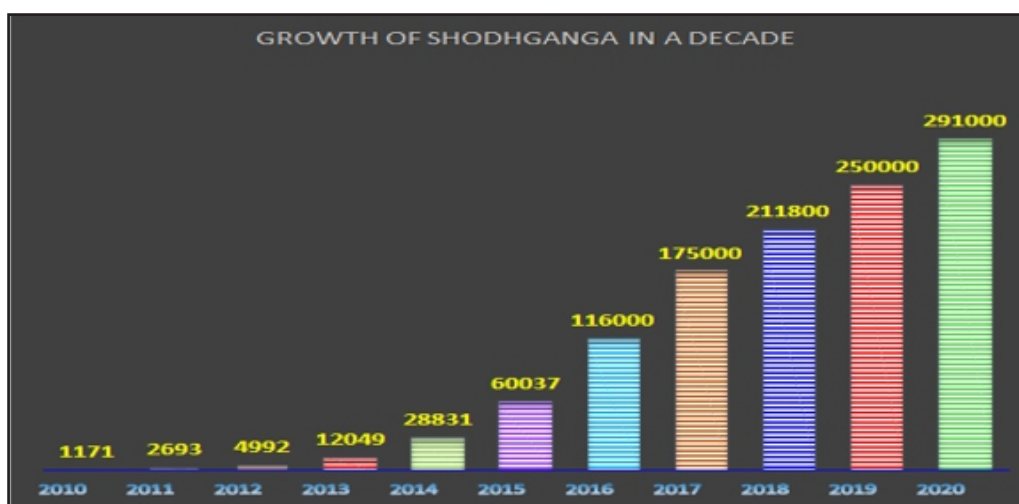
## **Shodhganga**

Shodhganga: a repository of full-text theses in Indian Universities has grown progressively during the period under report. As on 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2020 (584 universities + CFTIs) have signed MoU on Shodhganga with the INFLIBNET Centre where 28 MoUs were added during the period. Total number of theses deposited in the repository has grown to 2,91,000+ deposited by the contribution by 475+ Universities.

Figure-3 shows the Theses uploaded during October to December 2020 is 8233 whereas Figure-4 shows that the total Theses submitted to the repository reached at 2,91,000 and also the growth of Shodhganga in a decade (i.e. 2010-2020). However, despite the closure of many Universities and their research activities during the national lockdown, the status of Theses additions in Shodhganga shows a sum of 41,000 Theses added in the year 2020.

## Plagiarism Detection Software (PDS) under ShodhShuddhi

The Ministry of Education through its initiative ShodhShuddhi provides access to Plagiarism Detection Software (PDS) to all universities including Central, State, Deemed and Private Universities, as well as Centrally Funded Technical Institutions (CFTIs) in India through Central funding to enhance academic

integrity in academic institutions and to curb plagiarism, w.e.f. 01st September 2019. This program was launched by the Hon'ble Minister of Education during the CABE meeting in Vigyan Bhavan, New Delhi and it is being executed by INFLIBNET Centre, Gandhinagar.

Considering the low usage of submissions for plagiarism check because of lockdown due to Covid-19, the Plagiarism Detection Software (PDS) for the current year period is extended until 31st May 2021 and for the second year contract term will commence from 1st June, 2021 to 31st May 2022 with a minimum commitment of 6,00,000 documents. Usage over committed documents will be managed in the slab system of 1,00,000 documents so that Universities will not face any problem in use of PDS. It is also noted the increase in usage in the last 3 months, even though the academic Institutions have not opened with students' presence.

The Plagiarism Detection Software (PDS) has been provided to all identified 1038 Universities/Institutions by creating a user ID and Password for University Coordinators (UC) with admin rights. As on 31st December 2020, a total 9,09,524 Documents have been submitted for plagiarism checking by 1,01,593 users from 759 Universities Universities/institutions. The rest of the Universities are either using the other software or research programmes have not yet started.

## PDS Usage Statistics

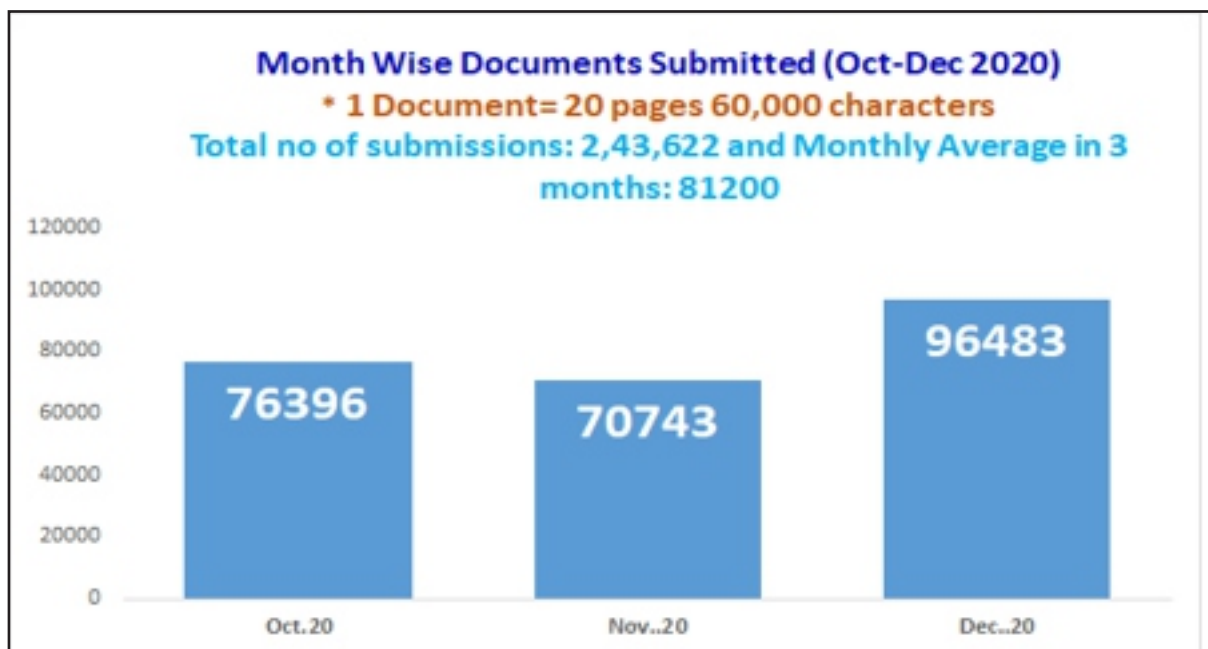
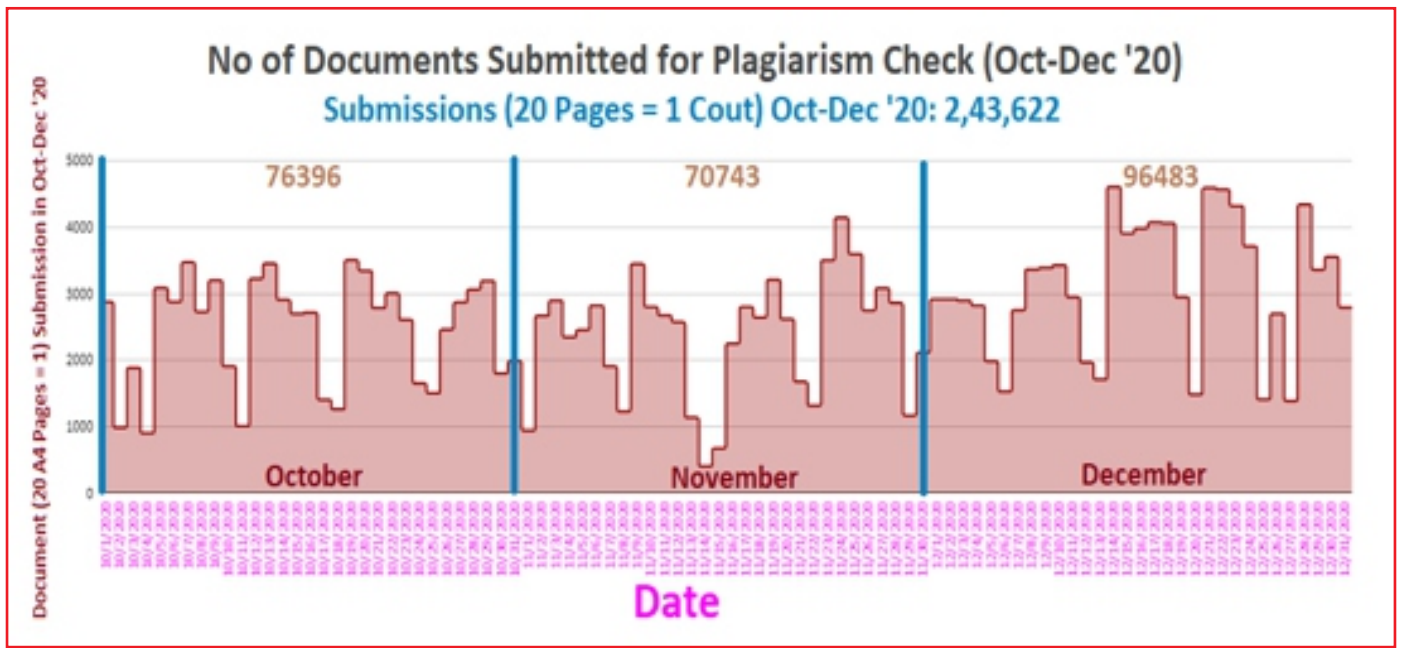
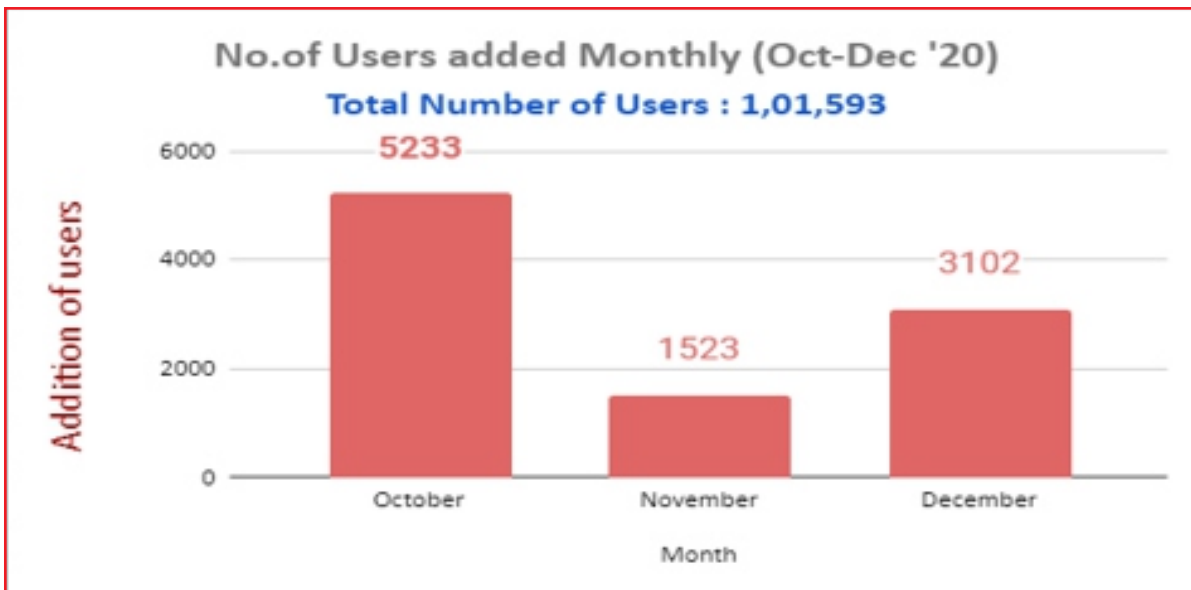


Figure-5: No. of Submissions in PDS month wise (October - December 2020)

Afterwards of the lockdown relaxation in July, submission into PDS has increased as researchers and students are gradually coming back to research and academic activities. Figure-6 shows the average number of submissions in the last 3 months (Oct-Nov-Dec), and the average is 81,200 which is highest after introducing the initiative.

The graph represented in Figure-7 shows the total number of users created/added in ShodhShuddhi till date are 1,01,593 whereas No. of users added monthly (Oct-Dec '20) are as follows (October= 5233, November= 1523 and December= 3102). PDS has provision for 3 Lakhs users from all Universities.

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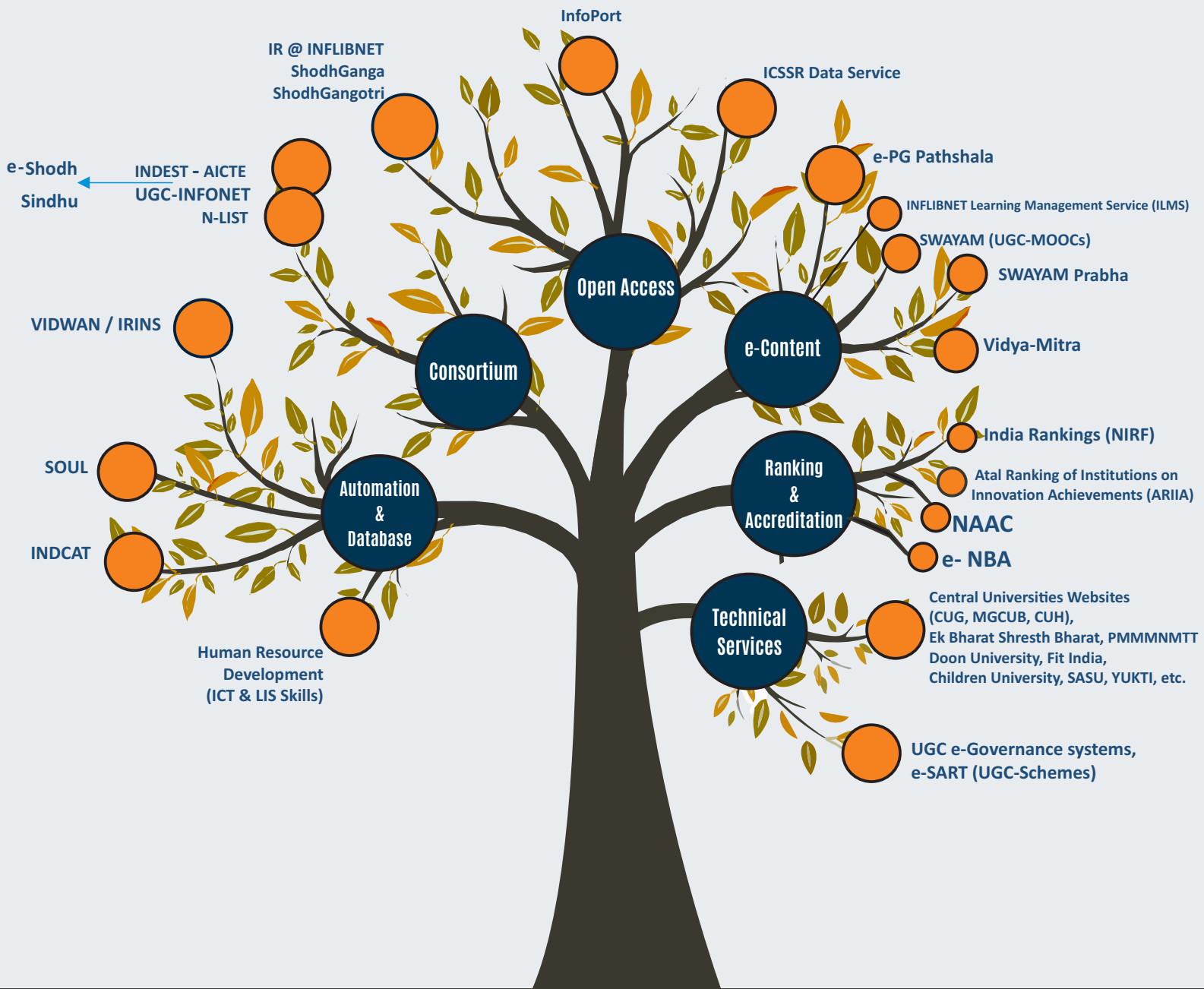
